COLLEGES WITH THE MOST DRAFT CHOICES

In the Jaguars' 20-year draft history, there have been 11 schools with three players drafted, three schools (Florida State, Virginia and Tennessee) with four players drafted, one school (Southern California) with seven players drafted and one school (Florida) with eight players drafted. The Jaguars selected three players from Florida schools in the 2014 draft: QB Blake Bortles (Central Florida) in the first round, G Brandon Linder (Miami) in the third round, LB Telvin Smith (Florida State) in the fifth round and RB Storm Johnson (Central Florida) in the seventh round.
