**TRANSACTIONS:** Originally selected in the third round (70th overall) of the 2012 draft.

**PRO:** Has played in all 45 games after being selected in the third round of the 2012 draft ... Ranks first in franchise history in career punting average (46.7) and net punting average (40.3) ... Holds top two marks in team history for single-season gross average, net average and most punts in a season with 95 in 2013 and 91 in 2012 ... Recorded 31 punts inside the 20 in each of his first two seasons, the third-most in team history ... Of his 262 career punts, 88 went for 50-plus yards and 21 for 60-plus yards ... Has five of the 12 longest punts in franchise history including a career-long 73-yarder on Nov. 4, 2012 against Detroit ... Set NFL rookie records and franchise records in 2012 for gross and net punting, finishing with a 47.8-yard average and 40.8-yard net on 91 punts ... Also set team records for single season gross and net averages, as well as mark for most punts (91), surpassing Bryan Barker's 85 in 1998 ... NSelected with the 70th overall pick in the third round, the highest a punter has been selected in the NFL draft since 1995 (Todd Sauerbrun, 54th overall, Chicago) ... Highest drafted specialist in Jaguars history and fifth overall, and third punter selected overall (David Leaverton, 5th round, 2001; Adam Podlesh, 4th round, 2007) ...

**2014: 9/7 at PHI:** Opened season with eight punts for a 46.5-yard average and 38.8-yard net with two downed inside the 20 ... **9/14 at WAS:** Punted eight times for the second consecutive game and totaled a 47.9-yard average and 40.5-yard net. Had five punts of 50-plus yards and two downed inside the 20 ... **9/21 vs. IND:** Punted five times for 46.4-yard average and 42.4 net with one downed inside the 20 ... **9/28 at SD:** Had two punts (48 and 63 yards) and finished with a 45.0-yard net ... **10/5 vs. PIT:** Punted five times for 45.0-yard average and 41.0-yard net with one downed inside the 20 ... **10/12 at TEN:** Had six punts for 47.7-yard average and 41.7-yard net with long of 64 ... **10/19 vs. CLE:** Matched his season-high with eight punts for 345 yards (43.1 avg.) for a 37.4-yard net. Had three punts downed inside the 20 ... **10/26 vs. MIA:** Punted four times for 46.8-yard average and 44.3-yard net with two downed inside the 20. Three of his four punts went for 50-plus yards ... **11/2 at CIN:** Punted six times and had one tipped and one blocked. Finished with a 41.7-yard average and 27.1 net with one punt downed inside the 20 ... **11/9 vs. DAL:** Had six punts for 47.2-yard average and 39.8-yard net. Had a 60-yard punt ... **11/24 at IND:** Totaled 49.4-yard average, 42.6-yard net, on seven punts with three downed inside the 20 ... **11/30 vs. NYG:** Had a season-high 45.6-yard net average on seven punts. Had four punts of 50-plus yards including season-long 66-yarder ... **12/7 vs. HOU:** Punted four times for 48.3-yard average and 38.0-yard net ...

**2013:** Served as the punter and holder in all 16 games ... Finished with a franchise-record 95 punts for a 45.7-yard average and 40.5-yard net ... His gross and net averages were second-highest of his career and second-highest in franchise history ... Matched his career-high with 31 punts inside the 20 ... **9/8 vs. KC:** Set a franchise record with 11 punts for a 50.5-yard average and 41.5-yard net average. Had two punts downed inside the 20 ... **9/15 at OAK:** Punted eight times for 349 yards (43.6 avg.) and 39.5-yard net average. Had three punts downed inside the 20. His 19 punts through the first two games were most in team history ... **10/6 at STL:** Had five punts for a 48.2-yard average with a long of 54. Matched his season-best with a 45.2-yard net average for the second consecutive week ... **11/10 at TEN:** Had his fifth game of the season with at least seven punts, totaling a 43.4-yard average, 38.4-yard net, on seven punts. Had three punts downed inside the 20 ... **11/17 vs. ARI:** Had a career-high six of eight punts downed inside the 20. Finished with a 47.8-yard average and 45.0-yard net with a long of 58 yards ... **12/1 at CLE:** Downed four of seven punts inside the 20. Finished with a 43.7-yard average and 33.9-yard net ... **12/22 vs. TEN:** Recorded four punts for a 45.5-yard average and a season-best 45.8-yard net with two downed inside the 20 ...

**2012:** Appeared in all 16 games as a punter and also served as holder ... Punted 91 times for 4,353 yards (47.8 avg.) and 40.8 net with 31 punts inside the 20 ... Set NFL rookie and team records for gross and net average ... Ranked third in the NFL with 40 punts of 50-plus yards, sixth with a 47.8-yard average and seventh with a 42.4-yard net average ... **9/9 at MIN:** Made NFL debut with four punts for a 53.5 yard average (net 43.0) ... **9/16 vs. HOU:** Punted nine times for a 52.6 yard average (net 43.5) with a long of 60 and three downed inside the 20. Made one tackle. The nine punts tied for the second-most in

team history for a game ... **9/23 at IND:** Had six punts for a 53.5 average (net 45.3) with a long of 66 and one downed inside the 20. The second quarter 66-yard punt was the fifth-longest in franchise history. Made one tackle ... **10/21 at OAK:** Called on for nine punts and finished with a 42.1 average (net 39.2) with a long of 55 ... **10/28 at GB:** Had a second quarter punt blocked by Davon House and recovered in the end zone by Dezman Moses for a TD. Produced a 40.6 average (net 30.5) on five punts with a long of 57 ... **11/4 vs. DET:** Recorded a career-long 73-yard punt in the first quarter, the fourth-longest in franchise history. Finished with a 50.5 average (50.5 net) on four punts ... **12/9 vs. NYJ:** Had eight punts for a 45.4 average (43.1 net) with a long of 55 and five downed inside the 20 ... **12/30 at TEN:** Had two of his five punts (46.4 avg.) returned for touchdowns by Darius Reynaud in season-finale.

**COLLEGE:** Four-year letterman, playing in 51 games ... Became only second player in school history to earn first-team all-conference honors in three straight seasons ... Punted 255 times for 11,094 yards (43.5 avg.) and 38.2-yard net ... His 43.5-yard career average ranked second in school history and sixth in Pac-12 Conference history ... Finished career with 90 of his 255 punts (35.3 pct.) downed inside the 20-yard line ... Had a 43.5-yard gross average, the second-best in school history ... Set school record as a junior with a 45.6-yard gross average ... Received the College Football Performance Awards' Elite Punter Trophy for his combined performance during the 2010 and '11 campaigns ... Credited with four of the 12 longest punts in school history including a career-long 76-yard punt at Stanford as a freshman ... Only player in school history to win the J. Scott Duncan Award as Cal's Most Valuable Special Teams Player for three straight seasons ... Recorded 53 punts for 44.2-yard average and career-best 39.7 net as a senior... Earned All-Pac 12 Conference first-team honors by the coaches ... Had 19 punts downed inside the 20-yard line, 13 fair catches and 17 returns for 100 yards ... Candidate for the Campbell Trophy, often referred to as the "Academic Heisman," and the Lowe's Senior Class Award ... Punted 62 times for 45.6-yard average and 39.1 net as a junior... Set 23-year old school single-season record for gross average, the sixth-highest in the nation ... His 39.1-yard net average ranked third in the nation ... Named to the All-Pac 10 Conference first-team by the coaches, joining Nick Harris (1999-2000) as the only punters in school history to earn all-conference honors in consecutive seasons ... Placed 21 punts inside the 20-yard line ... All-Pac 10 first-team selection as a sophomore ... Punted 69 times for 2,861 yards (41.5 avg.) ... Served as punter as a redshirt freshman ... Finished with 3,063 yards on 71 punts for a 43.1-yard average and 37.2 net ... Graduated in December of 2011 with a bachelor's degree in integrative biology.

**PERSONAL:** Attended Camarillo (Calif.) High School ... Did not begin punting until junior season ... Was named first-team All-America by EA Sports and USA Today as a senior ... Averaged 41.8 yards per punt with 11 punts downed inside the 20-yard line ... Listed as nation's second-best punter by Rivals.com ... Also saw action at WR and finished with 42 receptions for 678 yards and six TDs as a senior ... Selected as school's Scholar Athlete of the Year ... Son of Jean and Mike Anger ... Brother, Michael Jr. played football at San Diego and soccer at UC Irvine ... Full name: Bryan Corey Anger.
