TRANSACTIONS: Originally selected in the first round (5th overall) of the 2012 draft ... Suspended for four games for violating the NFL's Substance Abuse Policy on 4/30/13 ... Suspension lifted on 9/30/13 ... Suspended indefinitely for violating the NFL's Substance Abuse Policy on 11/1/13.

PRO: Second-year WR has started 19 of 20 games and has impressed as a number one receiver ... Set franchise rookie records in 2012 for receptions (64), receiving yards (865) and average per reception (13.5) ... Tied the club's rookie record with five receiving TDs ... Led team and tied for first among NFL rookies in receptions ... Led all rockies in receiving yards and tied for second rookies in receiving yards and yards are the rookies in receiving yards and yards are the rookies in receiving yards and yards are the rookies in ro in receiving TDs ... Started 15 of 16 games as a rookie, joining Reggie Willliams (15 starts, 2004) as the only receivers in team history to accomplish the feat ... One of only three rookies in team history to post a 100-yard receiving game, joining Pete Mitchell (1995) and Matt Jones (2005) ... Finished with 236 receiving yards on Nov. 18 at Houston, the second-most in team history and third-most by a rookie in NFL history ... Named to Pro Football Weekly All-Rookie Team ... Concluded the season with at least five catches in six of the last seven games ... Was first of four wide receivers selected in the first round ... Selected with the fifth pick of the draft, obtained from Tampa Bay in exchange for 1st (7th) and 4th (101)-round selections ... First player drafted by the Jaguars from Oklahoma State and highest drafted player at school since Barry Sanders (3rd overall) in 1989 ... Became fourth WR taken in the first round in franchise history, and 21st overall ... Left school following his junior season ... Two-time All-America selection and two-time winner of Biletnikoff Award as nation's top receiver ...

2013: Suspended without pay for the team's first four games of the 2013 regular season for violating the NFL Policy and Program for Substances of Abuse ... 9/16 at STL: Made season debut and led team with five catches for 136 yards (27.2 avg.) and one TD. Marked his second career 100-yard receiving game and second-most yards of his career (236 yards, Nov. 18, 2012 at Houston). His 27.2 yards per catch marked the 5th-highest in team history. Took first reception from Blaine Gabbert 67 yards for a TD, the second-longest reception of his career. Also had receptions of 39 and 14 yards ... 10/13 at DEN: Registered a career-high 14 receptions for 190 yards, his second consecutive 100vard receiving game. The 14 receptions tied for the third-most in team history and the most by a Jaquar since 2000. Was targeted a career-high 20 times and doubled his career-high for receptions in a game. Had 108 of his yards in the second half ... 10/20 vs. SD: Snapped a streak of two straight games with 100-plus receiving yards, finishing with six catches for 58 yards with a long of 12 yards ... 10/27 vs. SF: Caught four passes for 31 yards ... Suspended indefinitely for violating the NFL's Substance Abuse Policy on 11/1/13 ...

2012: Appeared in all 16 games as a rookie and made 15 starts ... Established franchise rookie records for receptions (64), receiving yards (865), TDs (5) and average per reception (13.5) ... Led team in receptions and ranked second in TDs ... Led all rookies in receiving yards and tied Tennessee's Kendall Wright for most receptions ... Made NFL debut in starting role on 9/9 at MIN and had three receptions for 24 yards. Caught two-point conversion pass from Blaine Gabbert in fourth quarter to build a 23-20 lead with 20 seconds remaining ... 9/30 vs. CIN: Led team with six receptions for 48 yards, including two catches of 14 yards ... Made three catches for 40 yards on 10/7 vs. CHI ... 10/21 at OAK: Took one snap at QB and handed off to Rashad Jennings ... 10/28 at GB: Totaled four receptions for 67 yards including a 36-yard reception in the first quarter ... 11/4 vs. DET: Made first career TD reception in the fourth quarter, a six-yard pass from Blaine Gabbert. Finished with five receptions for 32 yards.... 11/18 at HOU: Started at WR and posted a career high seven receptions for 236 yards and a TD. His 236 yards were second-most in a single game in franchise history (291, Jimmy Smith in 2000) and third-most by a rookie in NFL history. Caught an 81-yard touchdown pass from Chad Henne in the fourth quarter, the second-longest TD reception in franchise history. Also made receptions of 63 and 39 yards. Set franchise record with a 33.7-yard average per reception ... 11/25 vs. TEN: Paced team with five catches for 62 yards and a TD. Scored on a seven-yard pass from Henne in the fourth quarter ... Had a team-high six receptions for 57 yards on 12/9 vs. NYJ and followed with six catches for 93 yards on 12/16 at MIA ... 12/23 vs. NE: Scored on a three-yard pass from Chad Henne on the opening drive of the game and paced team with seven receptions for 79 yards ... Concluded season on 12/30 at TEN and made six receptions for 79 yards and a TD. Scored on a 30-yard pass from Henne in the second quarter.

COLLEGE: Two-time All-America selection and two-time winner of Biletnikoff Award as nation's top receiver ... Finished with 253 career receptions for 3,564 yards and 40 TDs ... Started 26 of 38 games ... Had 19 career 100-yard receiv-ing games ... Ranked eighth in NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision in receptions, fifth in receiving yards and second in TDs ... Only second two-time winner of the Biletnikoff Award as the nation's top receiver, joining Michael Crabtree of Texas Tech ... Set NCAA record with 14 straight games with 100-plus receiving yards and a TD ... Holds school single-season records for receptions (122, 2011), 100-yard receiving games (12, 2010), receiving yards (1,782, 2010) and TDs (20, 2010) ... His 40 career TD receptions ranked second in school history and fourth in Big 12 Conference history ... Played in all 13 games as a junior and finished with 122 receptions for 1,522 yards and 18 TDs ... Unanimous All-Big 12 Conference and All-America first-team selection and Biletnikoff Award winner ... Ranked third in school history for receiving yards and his 122 receptions set a school record ... Had seven 100-yard receiving games and reached 95 yards in two other games ... Did not catch a TD pass in the season-opener or regular season finale, but had at least one score in the 10 games in between ... Finished with 61 receptions for 860 yards and 10 TDs over the last six games ... Had NCAA-record 14 straight games with 100 receiving yards snapped at Tulsa ... Named Big 12 Conference Offensive Player of the Year as a sophomore by both the Associated Press and the league's coaches ... Became first offensive player of the year since Barry Sanders and was first receiver in Big 12 history to win the award ... Won Biletnikoff Award as nation's top WR as well as the Paul Warfield Award given annually by the Touchdown Club of Columbus to the best receiver in college football ... Produced the sixth-best receiving season in NCAA history with school-record 111 receptions for 1,782 yards with 20 TDs ... Averaged 16.1 yards per reception and ranked second in nation with 9.2 receptions per game ... Led nation with 148.5 receiving yards per game ... Posted 100-plus receiving yards and one TD in all 12 games ... His 1,782 yards were the most by a sophomore in NCAA history, surpassing Larry Fitzgerald's mark (1,672, 2003) ... Had at least a 29-yard reception and 105 receiving yards in every game ... Played in all 13 games as a redshirt freshman with four starts alongside current Dallas Cowboys WR Dez Bryant ... Finished with 20 receptions for 260 yards with two TDs ... Majored in business management.

PERSONAL: Single ... Attended Plainview High School in Ardmore, Oklahoma ... Lettered in football, baseball and basketball ... Earned SuperPrep All-Amer-... Lettered in football, baseball and basketball ... Earned SuperPrep All-America honors as a senior while leading team to a 12-1 mark ... Consensus all-state selection ... Totaled 61 receptions for 1,547 yards with 14 TDs in final season ... Added 152 rushing yards on 21 carries with two TDs ... Scored six special teams TDs and four TDs on INTs ... Was conference MVP in basketball as a junior ... Lettered one season in track, winning a state title in the long jump ... Born in Oceanside, Calif. ... Son of Warren and Donna Blackmon ... Father is a retired Marine ... Moved to Oklahoma while in the second grade ... Served as class president in high school and was a member of the choir ... Avid drummer ...
