PRO: Two-year starter at Central Florida, compiling a 22-5 record ... Third QB selected by the Jaguars in the first round, sixth overall, and highest drafted

in franchise history ... Highest drafted player in Central Florida history and only second QB to be drafted in school history (Daunte Culpepper, 2002) ... Second player drafted by the Jaguars from Central Florida in team history (Mike

2014: 9/7 at PHI: Dressed but did not play ... 9/14 at WAS: Dressed but did not play ... 9/21 vs. IND: Made his NFL debut after he was inserted into the lineup to start the second half and finished 14 of 24 passing for 223 yards with two TDs/two INTs for an 82.5 passer rating. Had four completions of 20-plus yards including a 63-yard TD pass to Allen Hurns. Also had 30 rushing yards including 20-yard rush. Engineered the offense to 289 yards in the second half after the club managed only 55 yards in the first half ... **9/28 at SD:** Made first career start and totaled 29 of 37 passing for 254 yards with one TD and two INTs for an 81.7 passer rating. Became 16th QB in Jaguars history to start a game as a rookie. Completed 78.4 percent of his passes, the highest in NFL history for a rookie quarterback in his first career start with a minimum 30 attempts. Hooked up with TE Nic Jacobs for a two-yard score in the second quarter. Had five carries for 24 yards. His 29 completions set single-game franchise record by a rookie and his completions, attempts and yards were most by a Jaguars rookie QB in first career start ... 10/5 vs. PIT: Started at QB for first time at home and was 22 of 36 passing for 191 yards with two interceptions for a 52.0 rating. Had four completions of 15-plus yards ... 10/12 at TEN: Started at QB and threw for a career-high 336 yards and one TD on 32 of 46 passing (69.6 pct.), tying Byron Leftwich (10/5/03 vs. San Diego) for most passing yards by a rookie in team history. His 46 attempts and 32 completions were the most in franchise history by a rookie. Had a 59-yard completion to Clay Harbor and hooked up with Harbor for a 20-yard TD pass in the fourth quarter. Marked first AFC South start. Led team in rushing with five carries for 38 yards ... 10/19 vs. CLE: Started at QB and was 17 of 31 passing for 159 yards with one TD and 3 INTs. Had 31-yard TD pass to Allen Robinson in the second quarter. Added five carries for 37 yards with a long of 18 yards. Had four completions of 20-plus yards ... 10/26 vs. MIA: Started at QB and threw for 221 yards and one TD on 18 of 34 passing. Had two interceptions, both returned for scores. Hooked up with Allen Robinson for a 48-yard TD in the fourth quarter ... 11/2 at CIN: Started at QB and posted a career-best 96.4 rating on 22 of 33 passing (66.7 pct.) with two TDs and one INT. Had TD passes to Allen Hurns of 40 and 18 yards. Matched his career-high with two TD passes. Added 10 yards on four rushes ... 11/9 vs. DAL: Started at QB and was 22 of 37 passing for 290 yards with one INT for a 73.0 rating. Had four completions of 20-plus yards including a 53-yard pass to WR Cecil Shorts. Added three rushes for three yards ... 11/24 at IND: Started at QB and threw for 146 yards on 15 of 27 passing. Had a 37-yard reception to Marqise Lee in the fourth quarter. The 27 attempts were his fewest of his career as a starter. Added five carries for 24 yards ... 11/30 vs. NYG: Started at QB and completed 21 of 35 passes for 194 yards with one TD for an 84.7 rating. Had first career fourth-quarter comeback win, leading team on a 11-play, 70-yard drive that culminated with a Josh Scobee FG. Had a 30-yard TD pass to Marqise Lee in the third quarter and finished with four completions of 20-plus yards. Added a career-high 68 yards on five carries including a 29-yard rush. Became only the third starting rookie quarterback to lead his team to a comeback win of 21 or more points since at least 1970 ... 12/7 vs. HOU: Started at QB and was 20 of 39 passing for 205 yards with one TD for a 64.6 rating. Had a four-yard TD pass to Allen Hurns in the first quarter, his first career TD pass in the first quarter. Had three completions of 20-plus yards ...

COLLEGE: Played in 37 games with 30 starts ... Declared for the NFL Draft following his junior season ... Compiled a 22-5 record as a starter ... Career totals included 585 of 891 passing for 7,598 yards with 56 TDs/19 INTs ... Ranked fourth in school history for passing yards and TDs ... Added 15 rushing TDs and 561 yards on 195 rushes ... Became only the second player in school history to produce multiple 3,000-yard passing seasons ... Concluded career with an interception/attempt ratio of .0273, recording only 19 interceptions in 891 passing attempts ... Became fourth player in school history to amass 8,000 yards of total offense, finishing with 8,159 total yards ... As a junior, finished 259 of 382 passing (67.8 pct.) for 3,581 yards with 25 TDs/9 INTs ... Led team to a 12-1 mark and a Fiesta Bowl win ... Named American Athletic Conference Offensive Player of the Year ... Semifinalist for Davey O'Brien Award ... Started all 13 games . Also named the Sporting News AAC Player of the Year ... Earned second-team All-American accolades from The NFL Draft Report ... Ranked seventh in the nation with 9.37 yards average per completion and ninth with 168.14 pass efficiency rating ... Had five 300-yard passing games ... Added six rushing TDs with 272 yards on 87 carries ... Collected 3,583 yards of total offense, seventh-most in NCAA Football Bowl Subdivision ... His 67.8 completion percentage ranked 10th-best among major college QBs ... Had a streak of 232 straight attempts without an INT, setting a school record ... Had 91-yard TD pass vs. Akron in the season-opener, the longest pass completion in school history ... Threw for a career-high 404 yards and four TDs vs. Temple ... Named MVP of the Fiesta Bowl with a win over Baylor, throwing for 301 yards and three TDs ... Won the starting job in the preseason as a sophomore and started all 14 games ... Was 251 of 399 passing (62.9 pct.) for 3,059 yards with 25 TDs/7 INTs ... Became only fifth player in school history to throw for 3,000-plus yards in a season ... Earned All-Conference USA honors, the first UCF passer to earn postseason league honors All-Conference USA nonors, the first UCF passer to earn postseason league nonors since 2002 ... Named team's Most Improved Player ... Became first QB in school history to register at least two TD passes in 10 games during a regular season ... Had a streak of 147 straight passing attempts without an INT and when that streak ended, he threw 174 passes without an INT, setting a school record ... Led conference with 7.67 average per completion ... Scored eight times on 87 carries and ranked second in conference with 3,344 yards of total offense ... His 33 total TDs ranked second in the conference ... Spent 11 games as a reserve QB as a freshman ... Completed 68.2 percent of his passes (75 of 110) for 958 yards with six TDs and three INTs ... Named to Conference USA's All-Freshman Team ... Redshirted as a freshman ... Majored in Interpersonal/Organizational Communication and minored in Sports and Fitness.

PERSONAL: Son of Suzy and Rob Bortles ... Attended Oviedo High School where he finished his career by setting Seminole County Records with 5,576 yards and 53 TDs ... Completed 151 of 233 passes for 2,211 yards with 27 TDs/7 INTs as a senior ... Central Florida was first university to extend a scholarship offer ... Captured MVP Award at the Central Florida All-Star Game following senior year ... Rated Florida's 8th-best player, according to the Orlando Sentinel's Florida Top 100 list ... Threw for 2,400 yards and 24 TDs as a junior ... Led team to district title as a sophomore and senior ... Also lettered on baseball team ... Graduated with 3.3 grade point average.
