



TRANSACTIONS: Originally drafted by Baltimore in the fourth round (123rd overall) of the 2011 NFL draft ... Waived on 08/31/13 ... Signed by Baltimore on 09/09/13 ... Signed by Jacksonville as an unrestricted free agent on 3/18/14 ... Placed on injured reserve on 8/29/14.

PRO: Fourth-year WR/PR spent his first three seasons with Baltimore after being selected in the fourth round (123rd overall) of the 2011 NFL draft ... In three seasons with the Ravens, he totaled 26 receptions for 428 yards (16.5 avg.) and returned 27 punts for 412 yards (15.3 avg.) and one TD ... Left college after his junior season and ranks among the top-ten in school history in receptions (fourth; 154), kick return yards (fourth; 1,549), receiving yards (seventh; 1,854) and all-purpose yards (seventh; 3,786) in 31 games (22 starts) ...

2013: Saw action in 15 games with two starts ... Had the best statistical season of his career with 19 receptions for 305 yards (16.1 avg.) and also returned 23 punts for 359 yards (15.6 ret. avg.) and one TD ... Finished fifth in the NFL (fourth in the AFC) with 359 punt return yards ... His 15.6-yard punt return avg. was the best in the NFL ... Returned two punts for 93 yards (46.5 avg.), including an 82-yard TD on 9/22 vs. HOU ... Had a season-high 99 receiving yards on four catches (24.8 avg.) on 10/13 vs. GB ...

2012: Appeared in 14 games in the regular season and all four postseason games en route to the Ravens' Super Bowl XLVII victory ... Caught seven passes for 123 yards ... Made his first career reception on 9/16 at PHI on a six-yard completion in the second game of the season ... Had a 39-yard completion in the Ravens victory over the Browns on 9/27 vs. CLE ... Caught the first TD of his career on a 15-yard reception on 10/21 at HOU ... Caught two passes for 28 yards and returned one punt for a season-long 40 yards on 12/16 vs. DEN ... Saw action at WR and on special teams in all four postseason games ...

2011: Played in six games during his rookie season ... Saw action at WR and on special teams ... Made his NFL debut on 9/25 at STL at WR and on special teams ... Saw action at WR and on special teams on 12/24 vs. CLE ... Was a gameday inactive for both playoff games.

COLLEGE: Three-year letterman ... Caught 154 passes for 1,854 yards (12.0 avg.) and 13 TDs in 31 career games (21 starts) ... Also returned 66 kickoffs for 1,549 yards (23.5 avg.) and 11 punts for 93 yards (8.5 avg.) ... Totaled 3,786 all-purpose yards on 273 plays (13.9 avg.), averaging 122.1 all-purpose yards per game ... Became the sixth player in Big Ten Conference history with 1,000 or more kickoff return yards in a season and set an Indiana single-season record with 1,016 kickoff return yards in 2010 ... His 1,854 receiving yards rank sixth all time at Indiana, while his 154 receptions stand fourth ... Became the 16th Hoosier to ever reach 100 career receptions and 1,000 career receiving yards ... Ranked first in the Big Ten and fourth nationally with an average of 175.8 all purpose yards per game and earned first-team All-Conference accolades from the league coaches as a senior in 2010 ... Ranked third on the team with 63 receptions for 706 yards (11.2 avg.) and a team-high 7 TDs ... Finished third on the team with 163 rushing yards and 1 TD on 28 carries (5.8 avg.) ... Played the majority of the season with a double sports hernia ... A first-team All-Big Ten choice by the league's media and second-team pick by the coaches as a junior ... In 2009, Led Indiana with 77 receptions for 962 yards (12.5 avg.) and 5 TDs ... His average of 80.2 receiving yards per game ranked second in the Big Ten and 30th nationally ... Also returned 25 kickoffs for 533 yards (21.3 avg.) and returned four punts for 44 yards (11.0 avg.) ... Finished fifth on the team with 14 receptions for 186 yards (13.29 avg.) and 1 TD as a freshman in 2008.

PERSONAL: Prepped at Ben Davis (Ind.) High School, earning three varsity letters while playing football ... Finalist for the Indiana Mr. Football Award during his senior campaign when he also earned first-team All- State, All-MIC Conference and All-Marion County honors ... Named Ben Davis' Most Valuable Offensive Player after leading the team to a 7-4 record and catching 37 passes for 538 yards and 4 TDs as a senior ... Added 1,164 yards and 12 rushing TDs on 174 carries, splitting time as a WR and RB ... Full name is Tandon Mic Doss ... Twitter handle is @TandonDoss.
