

**PRO:** Declared for the NFL Draft following his junior season ... Became only second Penn State player to be drafted by the Jaguars in franchise history ... Was second of two WRs drafted by the Jaguars in the second round (Marqise Lee) ...

2014: 9/7 at PHI: Made NFL debut and had one reception ... 9/14 at WAS: Led the team with 75 yards on four receptions including a career-long 54-yard grab in the fourth quarter ... 9/21 at IND: Made first career start and led the team with a career-high seven receptions for 79 yards (11.3 avg.) including a 21-yard reception ... 9/28 at SD: Started at WR and had five catches for 38 yards ... 10/5 vs. PIT: Started at WR and produced a team-high five catches for 51 yards (10.2 avg.) with a long of 17 ... 10/12 at TEN: Produced 68 yards on a career-high eight receptions, his fourth straight game with at least five catches ... 10/19 vs. CLE: Started at WR and led the team with 60 yards on four receptions including a 31-yard touchdown catch in the second quarter for his first career score. Snapped a streak of four straight games with five or more receptions ... 10/26 vs. MIA: Started at WR and scored a touchdown in his second consecutive game, hooking up with Blake Bortles for a 48-yard score in the fourth quarter. Led team with five catches for career-high 82 yards ... 11/2 at CIN: Was targeted eight times and finished with four catches for 35 yards ... 11/9 vs. DAL: Started at WR and was targeted a team-high 10 times, finishing with five catches for 60 yards (12.0 avg.) with a long of 31 yards ... Was placed on injured reserve on Nov. 17 with a foot injury. Had surgery on Nov. 22 ...

COLLEGE: Played in 35 games with 24 starts at Penn State... Finished career with 177 receptions for 2,474 yards (14.0 avg.) with 17 TDs ... Ranked second in school history for career receptions, topped by only Deon Butler (179, 2005-08), third in receiving yards and fourth in TDs ... Two-time Big Ten Conference Receiver of the Year and earned first-team All-Big Ten honors in back-to-back seasons ... Was just the third WR in school history to earn first-team All-American honors ... Led Big Ten in receptions and receiving yards in each of his last two seasons ... Became first player in school history to register a pair of 60-plus reception seasons ... Only player in school history with multiple 10-catch, 100-yard receiving games, accomplishing the feat four times in his career ... Joined Bobby Engram as the players in school history with multiple 1,000-yard receiving seasons ... Played in 12 games as a junior and totaled a school-record 97 receptions for 1,432 yards and six TDs ... First-team All-Big Ten selection ... Earned seven All-American honors including CBSSports.com first-team All-America ... Had eight 100-yard receiving games and became the third WR in school history with three consecutive 100-yard receiving games ... Had 71 catches for 984 yards in eight conference games ... Four of his six TDs were from 65, 51, 46 and 45 yards ... Became first player since at least 1985 to lead the Big Ten in receptions and receiving yards for consecutive seasons ... Ranked third in the nation in receiving yards per game (119.3) and ninth in receptions per game (8.1 avg.) ... Posted 13 catches of 35-plus yards ... tarted all 12 games as a sophomore at flanker and earned first-team All-Big Ten honors by the coaches, media, BTN.com and ESPN.com ... Candidate for Biletnikoff Award ... Set school single-season record with 77 catches for 1,013 yards (13.2 avg.) and a career-best 11 TDs ... Marked only the third 1,000-yard receiving season in Penn State history ... Led conference in catches, receptions per game (6.4), receiving yards and receiving TDs ... Had a season-high 10 catches at Virginia ... Delivered one of top receiving efforts in school history with a career-high 197 yards on 10 receptions for three TDs against Indiana . Appeared in 11 games as a freshman and made one start ... Was one of only four true freshman to see action ... Finished with three receptions for 29 yards ... Was enrolled in the College of Communications ...

**PERSONAL:** Single ... Attended Orchard Lake St. Mary's Preparatory School in Michigan ... Led team to Michigan Division III state championship game as a senior ... Had 44 receptions for 720 yards and 10 TDs as a senior ... Returned two punts for TDs and intercepted two passes ... Captain of the basketball team. Led all WRs at combine with 42-inch vertical jump ... Son of Tracie and Allen Robinson ... Born in Detroit ... Full name: Allen Bernard Robinson II.
