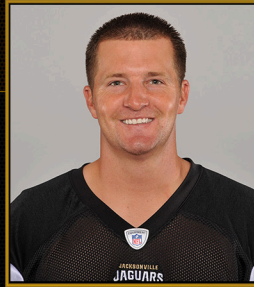

**TRANSACTIONS:** Originally drafted in the fifth round (137th overall) of the 2004 draft.

**PRO:** In his 11th season with the Jaguars, tied for the second-longest tenure in team history ... Has served as team's placekicker since being drafted in the fifth round of the 2004 draft ... Ranks third in team history with 165 games played ... Has connected on 230 of 284 field goals (81.0 pct.) and 312 of 317 extra points for 1,002 points ... Owns franchise career records for field goals and points and tied with Mike Hollis for the franchise record for consecutive made field goals with 20 ... Connected on a career-high 92.0 percent of his field goals (23 of 25) in 2011 and 2013, the second-highest percentage in team history ... Had streak of 61 consecutive games with a score snapped in 2009, the second-longest streak in team history ... Has converted 23 of 38 field goals (60.5 pct.) from 50-plus yards, the most in team history ... Owns the record for the four longest field goals in team history including a franchise-record 59-yard game-winning field goal on Nov. 3, 2010 vs. Indianapolis ... Connected on a 55-yard field goal and two 54-yard field goals in 2011 ... Tied an NFL record with three field goals of 50-plus yards (54, 54, 51) on Oct. 24, 2011 vs. Baltimore ... Has connected on eight game-winning field goals ... Has led the team in scoring nine of 10 seasons and joins Mike Hollis and Fred Taylor as only three players in Jaguars history to score 100 points in a season ... Set career-high with five field goals on Nov. 25, 2007 against Buffalo along with a career-high 18 points, and matched both numbers Oct. 10, 2010 at Buffalo ... Set franchise record with a field goal in 15 consecutive games from 2010-11 ... Scored 119 points in 2006, the third-highest single-season total in franchise history, on 26 field goals and 41 extra points ... Has been named AFC Special Teams Player of the Week six times in 10 seasons ... Was the second placekicker taken in the 2004 draft after Nate Kaeding in the third round ...

**2014: 9/7 at PHI:** Connected on a 49-yarder in the second quarter, was wide left from 50 yards and had a 36-yard field goal blocked. Hit on both extra point attempts and finished with five points. Snapped a streak of 21 straight made field goals dating back to Sept. 27, 2009 at Houston ... **9/14 at WAS:** Recorded two touchbacks on three kickoffs and connected on his only field goal attempt, a 36-yarder in the fourth quarter ... **9/21 at IND:** Made a 41-yard field goal in the third quarter and was perfect on two extra point attempts. All four kickoffs resulted in touchbacks ... **9/28 at SD:** Connected on both extra point attempts ... **10/5 vs. PIT:** Scored the club's only points, hitting field goals from 43, 35 and 36 yards ... **10/12 at TEN:** Was successful on both extra point attempts and had a 55-yard FG blocked with 12 seconds remaining ... **10/19 vs. CLE:** Was good from 30 yards in the third quarter, his only field goal attempt. Was perfect on three extra point attempts and recorded touchbacks on four of five kickoffs ... **10/26 vs. MIA:** Was two of three on field goals, hitting from 30 and 40 yards. Had a 48-yard field goal blocked in the first quarter. Two of his four kickoffs resulted in touchbacks ... **11/2 at CIN:** Connected on his only field goal attempt, a 25-yarder in the first quarter, and both extra point attempts ... **11/9 vs. DAL:** Connected on his only extra point attempt. Recorded one touchback on three kickoffs ... **11/24 at IND:** Hit a 28-yard field goal in the first quarter, his only attempt ... **11/30 vs. NYG:** Connected on his eighth career game-winning field goal, hitting from 43 yards with 28 seconds remaining. Also had a 28-yard field goal in the second quarter. Recorded five touchbacks on six kickoffs ... **12/7 vs. HOU:** Surpassed 1,000 career points, connecting on both field goal attempts (33, 37) and one extra point attempt ...

**2013:** Played in all 16 games and connected on 23 of 25 field goals (92.0 pct.), 22 of 23 PATs and had 36 touchbacks on 62 kickoffs ... Tied for the highest field goal percentage of his career ... Hit on 4 of 5 field goals from 50-plus yards ... Only two misses were a blocked FG and a 60-yard attempt ... **9/15 at OAK:** Connected on a 27-yard field goal in the second quarter, his only FG attempt. Had one touchback on three kickoffs ... **9/22 at SEA:** Hit on 33-yard FG in the third quarter and added two PATs. Recorded two touchbacks on four kickoffs ... **9/29 vs. IND:** Opened scoring with a 53-yard FG in the first quarter ... **10/13 at DEN:** Hit from 50 and 30 yards on his only two field goal attempts ... **11/10 at TEN:** Finished with nine points, connecting on both field goal attempts (32, 44) and all three extra point attempts. Had two touchbacks on six kickoffs ... **11/17 vs. ARI:** Recorded touchbacks on all three kickoffs

and was successful on both extra point attempts. Was wide left on a 60-yard field goal attempt to conclude the first half, his first missed field goal of the season ... **11/24 at HOU:** Was 2 of 3 on field goals including a 53-yarder in the fourth quarter. Had a 49-yard field goal blocked in the third quarter and connected on a 30-yard field goal in the second quarter ... **12/1 at CLE:** Had a season-high 12 points, hitting all three field goal attempts (44, 36, 25) and all three extra point attempts. Five of six kickoffs resulted in touchbacks ... **12/15 vs. BUF:** Connected on both field goal attempts, hitting from 32 and 55 yards. The 55-yarder tied for the second-longest of his career and longest since he hit from 55 yards on 9/18/11 at NYJ ... **12/22 vs. TEN:** Was successful on a 36-yard field goal attempt in the third quarter. Had an extra point attempt blocked on the second quarter ...

**2012:** Appeared in all 16 games and scored a team-high 93 points for the second consecutive season ... Opened the season with 14 consecutive field goals made and finished 25 of 28 (89.3 pct.), the second-highest percentage of his career and third-highest in team history ... Was 6 of 7 from 40-plus yards ... Added 26 touchbacks on 66 kickoffs and two special teams tackles ... **9/9 at MIN:** Connected on three field goals (19, 26, 47). Had extra point in second quarter blocked. The blocked try ended a streak of 82 consecutive extra points made, dating back to 11/8/09. The streak was the second-longest in franchise history (220, Mike Hollis, 10/22/95 - 12/9/01) ... **9/16 vs. HOU:** Became Jaguars career scoring leader with a third quarter extra point (765 points), surpassing Mike Hollis (764 points, 1995-2001) ... **9/23 at IND:** Converted all three field goal attempts (44, 47, 26), extending his consecutive field goals made streak to 12. Marked 14th game in his career with at least two field goals of 40-plus yards ... **10/21 at OAK:** Set franchise career record for field goals after hitting on all three field goal attempts (50, 40, 45) and extended his consecutive made field goals streak to 17. Executed a successful second quarter onside kick. Made one special teams tackle ... **10/28 at GB:** Was 3 of 3 on field goals (38, 22, 32) and extended his consecutive made field goals streak to 20, tying Mike Hollis' franchise record ... **11/8 vs. IND:** Misfired on a 44-yard field goal attempt in the first quarter, snapping a streak of 20 consecutive field goals made. Was good from 40 yards in the second quarter ... **11/18 at HOU:** Was successful on all three field goal attempts (43, 40, 33) and finished with 13 points ... **12/9 vs. NYJ:** Connected on a 31-yard field goal and missed a 55-yard attempt, both in the second quarter. ...

**2011:** Played in all 16 games for the fourth consecutive season and led team with 93 points ... Connected on 23 of 25 field goals (92.0 pct.), his most field goals made since 2006 ... His 92.0 percent field goal percentage was a career-high and the second-highest percentage in team history ... Ranked first in the AFC and third in the NFL for field goal percentage ... Tied his career-best by making his first 15 field goal attempts to start the season, equaling the third-best streak in team history ... Of his 23 field goals, 12 were from 40-plus yards including five of six from 50-plus yards (55, 53, 54, 54, 51) ... The five field goals of 50-plus yards were the most in team history and tied for the sixth-most in the NFL ... Set a single-season franchise record with 39 touchbacks on 62 kickoffs (62.9 pct.) and 58 of his 62 kickoffs (93.5 pct.) reached the end zone ... His 62.9 touchback percentage ranked fifth in the NFL and the 93.5 percent of kickoffs to the end zone was second-highest ... **9/11 vs. TEN:** Was successful on all three field goal attempts (48, 21, 45) and had a career-high five touchbacks ... **9/18 at NYJ:** Scored the club's only points with a 55-yard field goal in the first quarter, the second-longest field goal in franchise history. ... **9/25 at CAR:** Connected on a 53-yard field goal in the second quarter ... **10/16 at PIT:** Was two of two on field goals (46, 45), setting a franchise record by hitting a field goal in his 14th consecutive game ... **10/24 vs. BAL:** Connected on all four field goal attempts (54, 54, 22, 51) and scored all 12 of the club's points on Monday Night Football. Tied an NFL record with three field goals of 50-plus yards. Connected from 54 yards twice in the first half and was good from 51 yards in the fourth quarter. Named AFC Special Teams Player of the Week for his performance ... **10/30 at HOU:** Did not attempt a field goal, ending his franchise record at 15 consecutive games with a made field goal ... **11/13 at IND:** Made one of two field goal attempts, connecting from 44 yards in the second quarter and was wide right from 45 yards in the second quarter. Tied career-high with 15 consecutive made field goals and surpassed Mike Hollis (239) for most extra points in team history ... **11/27 vs. HOU:** Converted two of three field goals (21, 35) and only extra point attempt. Missed a 55-yard field goal in the second quarter, his only miss from 50-plus yards for the season. Added one special teams tackle ... **1/1 vs. IND:** Concluded the season four of four on field goals (25, 32, 47, 39) ...

**2010:** Led team with 107 points, tying second-most of career and most since 2005, with 22 field goals representing most in four years ... Converted first 14 field goal attempts of season for fourth-longest streak in team history ... First seven field goal attempts of season were all from 44+ yards ... Had just four games with multiple field goals but made at least one in all 15 games in which he had an attempt ... Kicked off 75 times and had 15 touchbacks ... Scored total of 23 points in first four games including 51-yarder **9/26 vs. PHI**, and capped that span with team-record 59-yard FG **10/3 vs. IND** on final play of game for 31-28 victory. The 59-yard FG was the third-longest game-ending FG in NFL history and tied for the eighth-longest FG in NFL history ... The next week scored season-high 18 points **10/10 at BUF**, making all five field goal tries and all three PATs in best game of season. Four of five FGs were from 40+ yards: 49, 49, 34, 40, 46 ... **11/14 vs. HOU:** Made 38-yard field goal for 14th consecutive to start season before missing next

two ... Played in 100th game **12/5 at TEN** and missed two field goal tries for only second time in season with 49-yarder blocked ...

**2009:** Played in all 16 games for the fifth time in his career ... Connected on 18 of 28 field goals (64.3 pct.) and 30 of 31 extra points for 84 points ... Reached the end zone with 33 of 63 kickoffs with 17 touchbacks, the fourth-most in the AFC ... Was 11 of 12 on field goals from less than 40 yards and four of nine from 50-plus yards ... Ranked tied for fourth in the NFL with four 50-yard field goals and his nine attempts were the most in the NFL ... **9/13 at IND:** Connected on two of three field goal attempts as he fell short on franchise-record attempt of 63 yards at the end of the first half. Converted field goals of 24 and 46 yards ... **10/4 vs. TEN:** Finished with franchise-record five touchbacks and 13 points. Was three of four on field goals including a 50-yarder. Was wide left on 55-yard field goal attempt at the end of the first half. ... **10/11 at SEA:** Did not attempt a field goal or extra point and had consecutive game scoring streak snapped at 61, the second-longest in franchise history ... **10/18 vs. STL:** Made 36-yard game-winning field goal in overtime. Was one of two on field goals, missing wide left from 58 yards at the end of first half ... **11/1 at TEN:** Finished one of two on extra points with his second attempt blocked ... **11/15 at NYJ:** Converted game-winning field goal from 21 yards ... **12/6 vs. HOU:** Connected on three of three field goals, hitting from 51, 46 and 24 yards ... **12/17 vs. IND:** Connected on a 50-yard field goal in the first quarter ...

**2008:** Played in all 16 games and connected on 19 of 25 field goals (76.0 percent) and 33 of 33 extra points for a team-high 90 points ... Established career-high with four field goals from 50-plus yards ... Kicked game-winning field goals in back-to-back games weeks three and four ... Had streak of 11 consecutive made field goals ... Part of special teams unit that led the NFL in opponents starting position after kickoffs (24.3 avg.) ... **9/14 vs. BUF:** Hit on all three field goals, connecting from 28, 50 and 39 yards. Converted an onside kick attempt in the third quarter ... **9/21 at IND:** Was three-for-three on field goals including a 51-yard game-winning kick with four seconds remaining in the game. Also connected from 26 and 21 yards. Became only the fourth player in team history to surpass 400 career points. Named AFC Special Teams Player of the Week for his performance ... **9/28 vs. HOU:** Connected on all three field goals including a 37-yard game-winning kick in overtime. Also hit from 46 and 40 yards ... **10/26 vs. CLE:** Connected on one-of-two field goal attempts, tying a franchise-record with a 53-yarder. First attempt of 38 yards was blocked by Shaun Rogers, ending a streak of 11 consecutive made field goals. Suffered a wrist injury in the game and was forced to wear a cast the remainder of the season ... **11/9 at DET:** Made 100th career field goal from 34 yards ... **11/23 vs. MIN:** Was one-of-three on field goals, connecting from 21 yards and missing wide left from 46 and 38 yards to mark only his third career game with two missed field goal attempts ...

**2007:** Played in only eight games after injuring right quadriceps in pregame warm-ups on opening day ... Connected on 12 of 13 field goals (92.3 percent) and 26 of 27 extra points for a team-leading 62 points ... Led the team in scoring for fourth straight season ... Missed eight games after playing in the season opener and ended a streak of 49 consecutive games played ... **9/9 vs. TEN:** Injured quadriceps in pre-game warmups. Connected on only FG attempt, hitting from 22 yards. Did not kickoff for first time in career. ... **9/16 vs. ATL:** Missed game and ended streak of 49 consecutive games played ... **11/18 vs. SD:** Returned to action after missing previous eight games with a quadriceps injury and played in 50th career game. Connected on only FG attempt of 48 yards ... **11/25 vs. BUF:** Connected on a career-high and tied team record with five of five field goals, hitting from 46, 33, 22, 23, 20. Attempted 100th career field goal. ... **12/23 vs. OAK:** Did not attempt a field goal but connected on a team-record seven PATs ... **1/5 at PIT:** In AFC Wild Card Playoff game, connected on one of two field goals, missing from 46 yards and hitting from 25. Made game-winning field goal with less than a minute remaining in the fourth quarter. ... **1/12 at NE:** In AFC Divisional Playoff game, connected on both field goal attempts from 39 and 25 yards ...

**2006:** Played in all 16 games and connected on 81.3 percent (26 of 32) of field goals and hit on all 41 PATs ... Ranked third in the AFC and fifth in the NFL with a career-high 119 points ... Finished with career-high 21 touchbacks which ranked second in the NFL ... Was 14 of 19 from 40-plus yards and hit a NFL-best 14 field goals from 40-49 yards ... Selected to USA Today All-Joe Team which goes to players who have overachieved and are often overlooked ... **9/18 vs. PIT:** Connected on all three field goal attempts which accounted for all the Jaguars scoring ... **10/1 at WAS:** Was three-for-three on field goals with all three from 40-plus yards, marking first time in career with three 40-plus yard field goals in a game ... **11/20 vs. NYG:** Tied then career-high with four field goals and finished with a season-high 14 points ... **11/26 at BUF:** Was one of two on field goals, ending a streak of 15 consecutive field goals made ... **12/3 at MIA:** Tied season-long with a 48-yard field goal ... **12/10 vs. IND:** Tied season-high with 14 points as he finished three of four on field goals, five of five PATs ...

**2005:** Led the AFC and ranked second in the NFL with 20 touchbacks on 77 kickoffs (26.0 pct.) ... Led the team in scoring with 107 points after connecting on 23 of 30 field goals and 38 of 39 extra points ... Ranked 10th in the AFC in points ... Won AFC Special Teams Player of the Week twice ... **9/11**

**vs. SEA:** Tied career-high with four field goals on five attempts, surpassing the 100 point mark in only his 17th career game. Also had four touchbacks, the only NFL player in Week One with multiple touchbacks ... **10/9 vs. CIN:** Was three for three on field goals and two for two on extra points for 11 points, including a 53-yard field goal that matched the team record ... **12/11 vs. IND:** Had one onside kick that was recovered by Rashean Mathis ... **1/1 vs. TEN:** Was two for two on field goals and four of five on extra points, snapping streak of 59 straight made extra points ... **1/7 at NE:** Hit on one of two field goals in AFC Wild Card game ...

**2004:** Led team in scoring with 93 points after connecting on 24 of 31 field goals and 21 of 21 extra points ... Finished season tied for third in AFC touchbacks with 11 touchbacks on 58 kickoffs ... **10/24 at IND:** Collected a season-high 13 points on four of four field goals and one extra point including the game-winning 53-yard field goal with 38 seconds remaining in the game and was named AFC Special Teams Player of the Week ... **11/28 at MIN:** Registered 10 points on three of three field goals, and one extra point and placed four of five kickoffs in end zone for touchbacks ... **1/2 at OAK:** Scored seven points on two of two field goal attempts.

**COLLEGE:** One of the premier placekickers in the country ... Won the kicking job as a true freshman and went on to set school career records, connecting on 66 of 92 field goals and 145 of 153 extra point attempts for 343 points ... Ranked second in field goal attempts in Western Athletic Conference history ... First-team All-WAC choice as a senior and earned second-team honors as a junior and sophomore ... Majored in sociology.

Was celebrity guest at 2009 Child Cancer Fund Golf Tournament ... 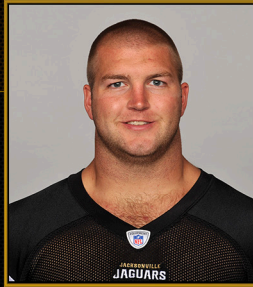
