2013: Spent the 2013 season with Arizona after signing on Oct. 22 ... Converted from a CB to WR ... Appeared in three games for the Cardinals, registering one special teams tackle on 11/10 vs. HOU and catching the only pass of his career, a 51-yarder on 10/27 vs. ATL ...

2012: Played in a career-high seven games for Indianapolis, but did not register any statistics ... Was waived by the Cowboys during final cuts and spent six games with the UFL's Sacramento Mountain Lions as a kick returner and CB ...

2011: Spent the 2011 season on Dallas' practice squad ...

2010: Originally signed as an undrafted free agent by Dallas on July 29 ... Spent the majority of the season on the practice squad before being promoted to the active roster on Dec. 21.

COLLEGE: Four-time All-American as a sprinter ... Won nine Southland Conference titles and received four Southland Conference athlete of the year awards .. In 2009, registered a 9.90 time in the 100 meters at the UTEP Invitational, the fastest time in school history and the fastest time in the world that season ... Only four-time All-American in school history ... Did not play football in college ... First NFL player from UTSA.
